Dr. Rolls is certified by the American Board of Surgery and the American Society of Transplant Surgeons and is a fellow of the American College of Surgeons. He specializes in abdominal solid organ transplantation, and also provides surgical care of dialysis access for end-stage kidney disease patients, as well as general surgical care.

Dental Coverage for Low-Income Adults in Delaware

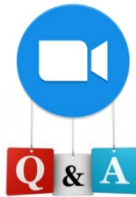
